Ponies not exceeding 138 cm, 4 years and over. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any breed. Snaffle bridles only.

45. Junior Ridden

Open to Mares or gelding 4 years old and over. Riders 18 years and under. Any suitable bridle.

46. Unaffiliated Novice Ridden

For true novices starting their ridden career,, stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs or over, not to have been shown under saddle before 1st January 2024. Must be ridden in a suitable snaffle bridle, no cantering on the go round, riders 12yrs and over. To exclude lead rein and first ridden.

47. Ridden Welsh Part Bred Horse or Pony

Open to horses or ponies 4 years old and over registered in the Welsh Part bred section of the WPCS stud book. To exclude lead rein and first ridden

48. Ridden Coloured Horse or Pony

Open to horses or ponies 4 years old and over. To exclude lead rein and first ridden

49. Open Ridden

Open to ponies and horses 4 years old and over of any breed or type

50. NPS M&M OPEN LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not Exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. (Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year)

51. NPS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not Exceeding 128cms. (Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year)

52. NPS/THE ANDREWS FAMILY Part Bred Ridden National Championship

Stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over. Part Bred M&M. Horse/pony to be registered in the part bred section of one of the M&M studbooks with a minimum of 12.5% of that breed blood. Horses/ponies may be shown plaited or unplaited to suit type. Rider any age, except stallions

NPS/ FREESTEP M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have been placed first in any ridden Mountain & Moorland class (excluding lead rein and first ridden) before 1st October in the current year. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Rider any age (except stallions—see NPS Rules)

NPS/ CASTLEFORD STUD CONFINED NOVICE M&M RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd from Classes 53-58) A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M Ridden section. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the 2025 NPS Summer Championship Show.

Conditions Of Entry

The Organisers, nor any of the show officers, servants or assistants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (for any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants, or any other member of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show.

The Committee reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason whatsoever

Any objections must be lodged, in writing, with the Secretary immediately with a deposit of £20.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.

The Committee reserve the right to change the judges, the decision of the judges & their interpretation of the rules will be final. A judge may require that a pony which constitutes a danger to leave the ring.

All entries MUST be registered, or be eligible for registration, with their eligible breed society. All ponies entering Medal classes must be registered/eligible for registration with Welsh Pony and Cob society.

In the event of the Show being cancelled for whatever reason, the Committee reserves the right to keep a portion of monies.

Exhibitors are **NOT** permitted to enter an animal in any class which is to be judged by a person who had, or has, any financial interest in the animal or been connected with it in any way. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or divide classes, if deemed appropriate. The Committee reserve the right to alter or amend the conditions. Exhibitors are requested not to bring a coughing horse to the show and may be requested to remove any such animal.

Fall of horse/rider in any class will result in disqualification (from that class).

All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday and the SCWP&CA recommend that a parent or guardian be available at the ringside when children are riding in classes off the lead rein.

Correctly fastened hard hats to the current recommended British Standard are to be worn at all times when mounted on any part of the Showground and although not a rule it is recommended by the SCWP&CA that all competitors 18 years and under wear a correctly fastened hard hat when showing in hand.

EXHIBITORS MUST ENSURE THAT THIRD PARTY INSURANCE COVERS THEM ADEQUATELY.

Barren mares not to have reared a live foal in the current year.

Plaiting of manes and tails is not permitted in In Hand pure bred classes.

Novice Ridden classes entrants to be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle.

Riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds and for large breeds riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January. All ridden stallions must wear a stallion disc.

LITTER – We would like to ask that everyone clear their own rubbish away. Black waste bins will be sited around the Showground. It would be sincerely appreciated if this was adhered to.

No horse or pony will be allowed to be chased, bagged or rattled outside the ring or by anyone standing at the ringside whilst the animal is in a class. The Committee will not tolerate any dangerous behaviour and it will result in the culprits being barred from future events.

Exhibitors entering classes that may clash do so at their own risk, **NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.**

No Ridden Entrants will be allowed to enter the ring once the class has commenced trot, no in hand entry may enter after the last pony has done its individual trot.

It is entirely the Exhibitors responsibility to ensure they are ready and waiting for their classes, SCWPCA accept no responsibility what so ever for Exhibitors missing classes. **Classes will not be held for competitors or horses competing in other rings.**

NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE SHOWGROUND.

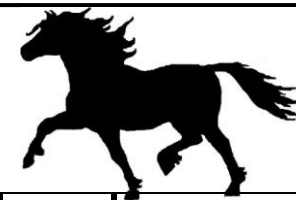
NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds. This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to members and non members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2025. The NPS General rules for showing apply (see NPS website for details). In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2024/2025 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2025 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: Affiliation No W24.003 These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. The owner's valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

This show is affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society. Affiliation No AF000243. Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards. Your personal data Exhibitor you will need to provide the WPCS with certain personal information relating to you.
